

In Govt. Memo. sixth cited, the Director of Tribal Welfare, Hyderabad/all Project Officers of ITDAs, were requested to follow the existing rules including rule of reservation issued in G.O. fifth cited for effecting promotions based on merit-cum-seniority of all eligible teachers including non-tribals who were appointed prior to issue of the G.O. third cited to various categories and to that extent the condition prescribed in the G.O. second cited stand modified.

In the reference seventh cited, the judgment of High Court is the very basis of the G.Os. first and second cited which are not enforce as the orders were issued in G.O. third cited in super-sessions of G.Os. first and second cited and orders issued vide reference sixth cited modify the orders of reference 2nd cited.

The clarification issued in Govt. Memo. sixth cited are hereby reiterated and the Commissioner of Tribal Welfare, Hyderabad/all Project Officers of ITADs in the State are requested to take action accordingly.
