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The attention of the Regional Joint Director of School Education, Kakinada is drawn to references read above, and it is informed that in the references 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Government has issued orders regarding provisionally allocated the cadre strength of the Commissioner of School Education in the District Offices amongst the 26 restructured districts and the same was communicated to the offices concerned in the state.

Further, in the references 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> read above, the Government issued orders restructuring the existing (53) Educational Divisions into (74) Educational Divisions within the restructured districts by reallocating the existing Deputy Educational Officer posts in district offices to ensure that each of the 74 Revenue Division has one Deputy Educational Officer post, thereby strengthening the divisional supervisory structure of School Education Department in the districts. Subsequently, the same was communicated to all District Educational Officers in the state vide reference 6<sup>th</sup> cited.

In the reference 4<sup>th</sup> read above, the Government transferred the Ganapavaram Mandal from Eluru Revenue Division in Eluru District to the Bhimavaram Revenue Division in West Godavari District, as detailed in the appended Schedule-I (Copy enclosed).

Therefore, the Regional Joint Director of School Education, Kakinada is hereby instructed to take necessary action in accordance with the orders issued by the Government in the references 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> read above, ensuring that the newly transferred Ganapavaram Mandal is considered

within the Bhimavaram Education Division of West Godavari District, rather than the Eluru Education Division of Eluru District, for administration convenience. Additionally, she is directed to inform the relevant District treasury authorities to take further action in this matter, ensuring that the specified Government Orders (GOs) are duly communicated.

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ORDER:

Government have issued orders for restructuring of existing (13) districts into (26) districts in the State of Andhra Pradesh to take Governance to the doorsteps of the citizens, with the avowed objective of improving the lives of the citizens of Andhra Pradesh and enhancing their satisfaction. The existing (13) districts were organized into (26) districts as a part of decentralization and the smaller administrative units will bring better transparency, administration, and more smoother and effective delivery of welfare in Andhra Pradesh. Further, the number of people living in each district has been brought down to facilitate better administration and complete focus on each district. In the State, there are 74 Revenue Divisions, however, the Educational Divisions are only 53, resulting in that after restructuring of districts, certain mandals which are in the jurisdiction of one educational division fall into the geographical boundaries of another District/Revenue Division.

2. The posts of Deputy Educational Officers (Dy.E.Os) which were created in the existing 53 Educational divisions in the State basing on the number of schools functioning in the district, are as detailed below:-

3 For ease of administration and effective monitoring of Schemes and Schools in the newly formed districts, the restructuring of Educational Divisions is necessary. To assimilate the revenue divisions with educational divisions, as post-restructuring of districts, certain mandals which are in the jurisdiction of one educational division fall into the geographical boundaries of another District/Revenue Division. As the several prestigious flagship programmes are being implemented by the School Education Dept., by bringing educational reforms viz., Mana Badi-Nadu Nedu, Jagananna Vidya Kanuka, JVD, Jagananna Ammavodi, Jagananna Gorumudda (Mid Day Meals), TMF, SMF, Byjus content, Smart TVs, IFPs etc, proper monitoring and implementation of these programmes at ground level, is very much essential, to bring out the optimum results desired by the Government.

4. To be more prudent in coordinating with the divisional level officers in Revenue Dept., i.e., Revenue Divisional Officer, in effective implementation and monitoring of the Government prestigious flagship programmes, it is essential for the educational divisions to be co-terminus with the Revenue Divisions. The objective for restructuring the Education Divisions is to ensure the optimum learning outcomes of the students through close monitoring of the teaching-learning activity right from the school level.

5. The parameter for formation of the Education Division is the number of schools to be monitored by each Mandal Educational Officer who in turn will report to the Deputy Educational Officer at Division level. The existing Educational Divisions are established during 1960s when approximately 15,000 schools were there in the erstwhile Andhra Pradesh State and about 121 Educational Divisions were established, with an average of 124 schools, which were fallen under the control of each Dy.EO. Whereas, now there are around 60,000 schools in the present State of Andhra Pradesh post bifurcation of the State and 53 Educational Divisions were allotted to the State. Approximately, 1132 schools are falling under the control of each Dy.E.O, thereby multiplying/ increase in the workload by 10 times on each Dy.E.O. Therefore, in order to streamline the inspectorate for better monitoring and supervision, it is proposed to restructure the existing (53) Educational Divisions and for formation of the Divisions by clubbing the Mandals co-terminus with the 74 Revenue divisions for effective administration and better reporting system.

6. The Commissioner of School Education, in the references read above, has reported that the required 74 posts of Deputy Educational Officers (Dy.Eos) for the proposed 74 Educational Divisions on par with the revenue divisions, to be carved out in the following manner:-

7. The Commissioner of School Education, has further stated that, the Government have converted and upgraded 998 Gr.II Headmaster posts, vide G.O. Ms. No.137, School Education (Ser.II) Dept., dated 23.08.2022, which includes 8 Gr.II Headmaster posts, which can be adjusted in place of the 8 Gazetted Headmasters Gr.I posts. These (8) Gazetted Headmaster Gr-I posts, which are in the same cadre of Dy.E.O in position and scale of pay, may be utilized by renaming as Deputy Educational Officers.

8. The Tribal Welfare Department have given their consent for utilization of the (03) Dy.E.O posts under their jurisdiction, stating that though the said 03 Dy.E.O posts are under the cadre strength of the Tribal Welfare Dept., they will attend all the duties of the School Education Department in the Tribal areas, on par with the DEOs/ Dy.EOs of the School Education Department in plain areas.

9. The (13) Dy.E.O posts of Zilla Parishads, are part and parcel of cadre strength of the School Education Department, but kept under the control of CEOs of 13 Zilla Parishads of erstwhile Andhra Pradesh State under the name of Parishad Educational Officer, vide G.O.Ms.No.259, Dt:09.02.1962 and renamed as Deputy Educational Officer (Zilla Parishad) in 2005 and are vacant for about last two decades. It is proposed to change the nomenclature of Deputy Educational Officer (ZP) as Deputy Educational Officer, on par with the existing Deputy Educational Officers who are executing duties viz., visits, inspections, monitoring etc., to all the schools under both the Government and Parishad Managements.

10. The Panchayatraj & Rural Development Department have agreed to the above proposal, in the interests of the better management of all the public schools in the state.

11. Government, after careful examination of the matter, hereby order to restructure the existing (53) Educational Divisions into (74) Educational Divisions in the restructured districts by re-appropriating the existing Deputy Educational Officer (Dy.E.O) posts in district offices to ensure @ one Deputy Educational Officer post for all 74 Revenue Divisions, to strengthen the divisional supervisory structure of School Education Department in the districts, as carved out in the following manner, duly changing the nomenclature of the Deputy Educational Officer (Zilla Parishad) as Deputy Educational Officer in Education Department:-

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I wish to inform that, Government in ref 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> cited have issued orders constituting a State Level Committee (SLC), chaired by Chief Secretary to Government, to study the aspects related to restructuring of the districts and under take appropriate measures for optimal utilisation of



existing resources in the creation of districts.

Further, in ref 3<sup>rd</sup>& 4<sup>th</sup> cited, the Government constituted four Sub-Committees (SCs) to assist the SLC in its mandate. The Sub-Committee-II (Structural & Personnel Reorganization) constituted under the Chairmanship of the Secretary, (Services), GAD to look into structural / personnel reorganization at the State / District / sub-District levels and given certain mandates to do the exercise.

3) I submit that, in ref 5<sup>th</sup> cited, the Government have issued the preliminary Gazette Notifications duly notifying the proposed restructured *districts and revenue divisions* and obtained suggestions from the all people from all corners of the State. Further, in ref 7<sup>th</sup> cited, the Government have issued final gazettes duly restructuring/formation of 13 Districts in to 26 Districts with 74 Revenue Divisions in the State.

3) I submit that, in ref 6<sup>th</sup> cited, the Finance (HR.I-Plg.& Policy) Department has issued detailed procedural guidelines for provisional allocation of posts & personnel in the restructured District/Division offices. (i.e., core principles, procedure for district offices, procedure for division offices and detailed procedure for provisional allocation of posts and personnel). Accordingly, in [ref 10th cited](#), all personnel (DEO to last cadre) were provisionally allocated to the restructured districts based on the functional requirement of the Department.

4) Further, in [ref 11th cited](#), FAC arrangements were made to the posts of Deputy Educational Officers (DyEOs) to the existing 50 Educational divisions in the State which were created basing on the number of schools functioning in the districts. The following are the District wise Existing Educational Divisions in the State after bifurcation of the erstwhile state of Andhra Pradesh:

5) In addition to these, there are 13 divisions along with 13 Dy EO posts also in existence for monitoring of the Schools under local bodies i.e., Zilla Parishads.

6) Further, I submit that, out of the above 53 posts of Deputy Educational Officers, the Government vide G.O. Ms. No.1 School Education, Dt:05-01-2022 has transferred 03 posts of Agency Deputy Educational Officers i.e., , 1. DyEO(agency), Parvathipuram, 2. DyEO(Agency) Seethampeta and 3. DyEO (agency), Kota Ramachandrapuram along with the 2 post of DEOs viz. 1. DEO, Paderu, 2. DEO, Rampachodavaram, to the Tribal Welfare Department.

7) I submit that, the geographical boundaries of educational divisions and revenue divisions are different and each educational division will be headed by the Deputy Educational Officer concerned. The details of the Education/Revenue divisions in the State are as follows:

8) The existing (13) districts were re-organized into (26) districts as a part of decentralization and the smaller administrative units will bring

better transparency, administration, and ensure smoother and effective delivery of welfare and services in Andhra Pradesh. Further, the number of people living in each district has been brought down to facilitate better administration and complete focus on each district. Resulting in that, certain mandals which are in the jurisdiction of one educational division fall into the geographical boundaries of another District/Revenue Division.

8) In this connection, I submit that, there is a dire need of restructuring existing 50 Educational Divisions into 74 Educational Divisions on par with the new 74 Revenue Divisions for proper monitoring, supervision of schools, visits, inspections etc., and for better implementation of the Flagship programmes like Jagananna Vidya Kanuka, Jagananna Ammavodi, Naadu-Nedu, Jagananna Gorumudda (Mid Day Meals), School Sanitation (TMF), School maintenance ( SMF), Printing and Distribution of Text Books, conduct of Exams, Pre- service and In-service Teachers Training etc. which are initiated and are being implemented by the Government from time to time.

9) As to accommodate additional DyEO's 13 posts of DYEO in existing ZP Divisions may be withdrawn and may be organized as per the new structure as these posts are in all District Head Quarters at CEO zilla Parishad offices, 08 Gazetted Head Masters posts which are sanctioned are available in the State, which is an equivalent cadre of Deputy Educational Officers may be renamed as DyEO's. The 3 Dy.EOs (Agency) which were transferred to Tribal Welfare Department earlier, may be re-allotted and adjusted to the proposed new educational divisions in School education.

10) In light of the above, the required 74 posts of Dy.EOs for the proposed 74 Educational Divisions on par with the revenue divisions may be carved out in the following manner:

The above reorganization doesn't require sanction of any additional posts and will not have any additional financial burden on the state exchequer.

11) Further, I submit that, in ref [12th cited](#), the Panchayat Raj Dept., notified that, the formation/reorganization of the new districts *will not have any effect on the powers and jurisdiction of the existing Zilla Praja Parishads constituted in pursuance of Section 177 of the AP Panchayat Raj Act, 1994 (Act No.13 of 1994) till the tenure of existing Zilla Praja Parishad is completed.*

12) In view of the above, I request the Government kindly to issue orders on the above lines for enhancement of 50 existing Educational Divisions to 74 Educational Divisions on par with the 74 Revenue divisions in the restructured districts in the State by duly reallocating one Deputy Educational Officer post to each for the proposed 74 Educational Divisions, with out any need for sanction of additional posts or any additional financial burden to the state.
